NEWS FROM THE MARCH MEETING

Because of the Missouri legislature's Easter break, State Sen. Joe Keaveny and Mo. Rep. Mike Colona were able to give us their progress report. There is talk of a statewide sales tax to pay for highway construction and a sales tax on internet purchases. Our aldermen and NSO's reminded us of the 50-50 program for replacing broken or hazardous sidewalks. While we are hearing of Veolia, a company studying our waterworks, the city charter does not allow St. Louis is sell it. Officer Don Veile warned owners of older cars not to let down their guard--older cars are valuable when sold for scrap because they have better metal and can be sold without a title. Guest speaker Pat Steger of H&RBlock offered assistance with filing extensions and a "second look" at our tax returns, and mentioned a future change--tax penalties for not having health insurance and the inclusion of employer provided insurance on the W-2.
