Our city government, including the Circuit Attorney's Office has organized ways for the city's 79 neighborhoods to participate in keeping down crime and related problems and to demonstrate to the courts how concerned we are about keeping our neighborhoods good places to live. Tilles Park Neighborhood Association, our neighbors to the west, made NOM the major topic of their last meeting Tuesday, August 25 and several of us attended. In addition to Alderman Joe Vaccaro and NIS Annette Bridges, the chief homicide prosecutor of the Circuit Attorney's office and Police Chief Dotson were part of the presentation. Several Kingshighway Hills residents, including KHNA President Brendan Gates, were in attendance. WHY WE SHOULD WORK WITH TILLES PARK...
